NOTICE OF HEARING AND LETTING

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AND FORM OF CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE CEDAR RAPIDS LINN COUNTY SITE NO. 1 LANDFILL GAS COLLECTION AND CONTROL SYSTEM MODIFICATIONS FOR THE CEDAR RAPIDS LINN COUNTY SOLID WASTE AGENCY, LINN COUNTY, IOWA, AND THE TAKING OF BIDS FOR SUCH CONSTRUCTION

Notice is hereby given that there are on file with the Cedar Rapids Linn County Solid Waste Agency (the "Agency"), in the County of Linn, State of Iowa, proposed plans, specifications and form of contract for construction of the Landfill Site No. 1 Gas Collection and Control System Modifications as hereinafter described.

A hearing will be conducted on the plans, specifications and form of contract at 1:30 PM on the 16th day of June, at which time and place any person may appear and file objections to the proposed plans, specifications and form of contract for said public improvements. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, this public hearing will be held remotely. Any person interested in joining the meeting by internet or by phone should visit www.solidwasteagency.org or call 319-377-5290 to receive instructions for joining the meeting. Sealed proposals for the construction of said improvements will be received at the Cedar Rapids Linn County Solid Waste Agency, Site No. 2 Landfill, 1954 County Home Road, Marion, IA 52302, until **1:00 PM** on the **14th day of July**, and at such time and place will be opened and publicly read by the Director of the Agency. Proposals received will be acted upon at a meeting of the Agency to be held at the Cedar Rapids Linn County Solid Waste Agency, Site No. 2, 1954 County Home Road, Marion, IA 52302 at 1:30 PM on the 21st day of July.

The general nature of said improvements and the location is described as follows:

- Installation of drain tile system within landfill cover
- Installation of a 3' dia. HPDE knockout pot
- Removal of existing GCCS surficial header pipe
- Installation of buried GCCS header pipe and connection into existing flare skid system
- Pump replacement for GCCS condensate sump
- Installation of dual containment forcemain and connection into existing leachate management sump
- Demolition of existing landfill gas treatment and compression equipment and buildings
- Installation of fencing around existing flare skid system

All work is to be in accordance with the plans, specifications and contract documents prepared by Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC (ENGINEER) on file with the Director of the Agency, which are by this reference made a part of this notice as though fully set out and incorporated herein.

All proposals shall be made in duplicate on proposal forms furnished by Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC, and must be enclosed in a separate envelope and plainly identified and addressed to Cedar Rapids Linn County Solid Waste Agency, 1954 County Home Road, Marion, Iowa 52302. Each proposal shall be accompanied by a bid bond, certified check, cashier's check or certified credit union share draft in a separate sealed envelope in the amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount of the proposal. The certified check or cashier's check or certified share draft shall be drawn on a bank or credit union in Iowa or a bank or credit union chartered under the laws of the United States of America, and payable to the Agency as security if awarded a contract by resolution of the Agency, the Bidder will enter into a contract at the prices bid and furnish the required performance and payment bonds and certificate of insurance. The certified check, cashier's check, or certified share draft may be cashed, or the

bid bond forfeited, and the proceeds retained as penalty if the Bidder fails to execute a contract or file acceptable performance and payment bonds or provide an acceptable certificate of insurance within forty-five (45) days after the acceptance of its proposal by resolution of the Agency. No bidder may withdraw a proposal within sixty (60) days after the date set for opening bids.

Payment of the cost of said project will be made in cash from such fund or funds as may be lawfully used for said purpose.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a corporate surety bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price. Said bond shall be issued by a responsible surety approved by the Agency and shall guarantee the faithful performance of the contract and the terms and conditions therein contained and the maintenance of said improvements in good repair for not less than one (1) year from the time of acceptance of said improvements by the Agency.

The Agency reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to re-advertise for new bids and to waive informalities that may be in the best interests of the Agency.

Work under the proposed contract shall be commenced no later than 10 days after the Notice to Proceed is issued and shall be substantially completed on or before 60 calendar days after the Notice to Proceed is issued and shall be completed and placed into operation on or before 90 calendar days after the Notice to Proceed is issued, subject to any extension of time which may be granted by the Agency.

A **MANDATORY** Pre-bid Conference will be held at Cedar Rapids Linn County Solid Agency Site No. 1 Landfill, 2250 A St SW, Cedar Rapids, IA 52404, at **11:00 AM on the 30th day of June, 2020. To comply with current Agency practices, attendance will be limited to two representatives per prime bid responders. All attendants shall at a minimum wear non-medical, cloth-based face coverings.**

Plans and specifications governing the construction of the proposed improvements have been prepared by Foth, which plans and specifications and the proceedings of the Agency referring to and defining said proposed improvements are hereby made a part of this notice, and the proposed contract by this reference and the proposed contract shall be executed in compliance therewith. Said plans, specifications and proposed contract documents are now on file with the Director of the Cedar Rapids Linn County Solid Waste Agency and with the engineers, Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC at their office located at 411 6th Ave SE #400, Cedar Rapids, IA 52401 for examination by bidders.
