- 1. The Agency will continue to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the community through cost-effective and environmentally sound practices for the management of solid waste generated in Linn County.
- 2. The Agency is not siting a new landfill in Linn County and will continue to pursue alternative technologies and regional waste disposal options.



- 3. The Agency will aggressively pursue additional waste reduction strategies to divert targeted waste streams from landfill disposal.
- 4. The Agency will investigate public and/or publicprivate partnerships for integrated solid waste management practices.



- 5. The Agency is pursuing opportunities for:
 - Siting two or more transfer stations for receiving and sorting facilities in Linn County to collect, sort, process, and/or transfer recyclables, organics, and solid waste.
 - Waste processing and energy production technologies
 - A regional organics processing campus which could include anaerobic digestion and composting.
 - A waste management campus that offers household hazardous waste, recyclables collection, and other ancillary services.



6. The Forward 2044 planning, education, and outreach will remain transparent and inclusive to both public and private stakeholders.
